Course Modules

Module 6: Site-Specific Sound and Installation Practices

Gives the student the necessary knowledge to understand and create artistic research and works that refer to ideologies, individuals and particular spaces. A broad outline of artistic concepts and trends of the 20th and 21st centuries in the context of sound art is included. Spatial sound concepts in architectures, real and virtual, in relation to a study of affects is introduced. Critical perspectives on basic curatorial practices are considered.

Objectives:

To discover the fundamentals of listening to, experience of, and perception of space and spatiality through sound in social context.

To understand the history of spatial audio, its available technologies, techniques and approaches, uses and abuses.

To obtain a critical approach to the conception and realization of sound-related art works and develop strategies and practices for the exhibition of sound-based and sound related art works.

Outcomes:

Skills obtained that are required to conceptualize public sound art works and curate programs of sound art in dialogue with current trends.

Be able to program and implement multichannel spatialised audio with various softwares and platforms including large arrays of directional speaker systems and different media.

Develop a unique, non-violent and authentic approach to sound in relation to authority structures, cultural themes and taboos.

Contribute to a process of social composition in which the artwork plays a catalysing role.

Week 10: Documentation practices and field work

Week 11: Performance studies, resistance studies

Week 12: Social art and social performance

Week 13: Sound, virtual reality and possible world theory

Week 14: Sonic Fiction, approaches and philosophy of the real
